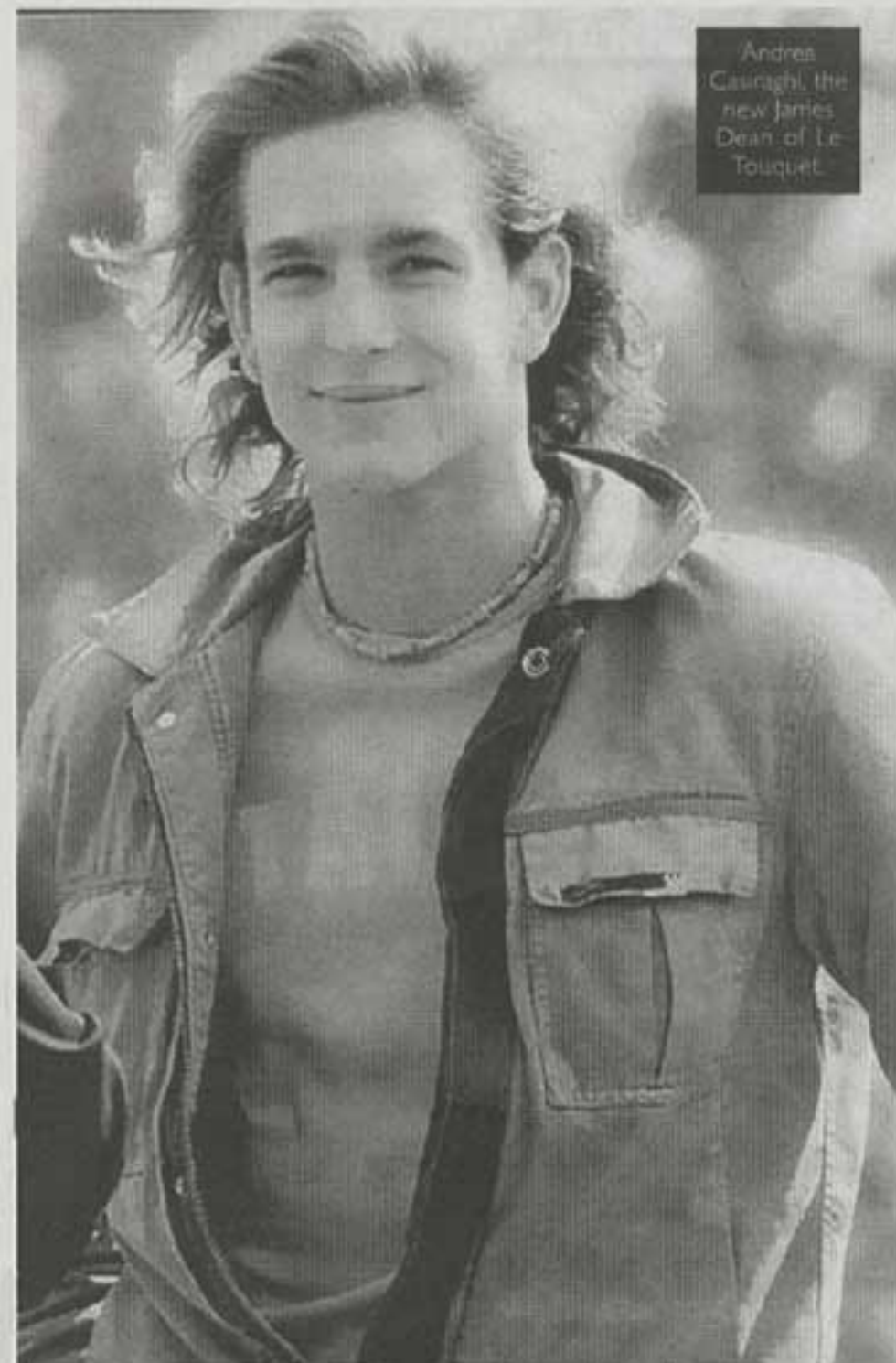

## Monaco's prince comes to Manila to visit mom's charity work

**A**ndrea Pierre Casiraghi, the son of Her Royal Highness Princess Caroline of Monaco and was once named one of *People Magazine's* 50 Most Beautiful People, will be arriving in Manila this August to visit the charity work of his mother for Amade-Virlanie Foundation, a socio-civic organization dedicated to providing shelter and guidance to abused children.

Considered a major heartthrob in the royalty and celebrity world, Andrea is the grandson of Princess Grace and Prince Rainier III of Monaco. His good looks and royal lineage made

this young man a favorite with the international press, somewhat along the same lines as Prince William of Britain. Known for his delicate blonde good looks and athletic skills—Andrea rides, skis, plays football and also plays guitar. He finished high school at the International School of Paris. He is fluent in French, English, Italian, and German.

Andrea Pierre Casiraghi was invited by Amade-Virlanie Foundation which, since its inception in 1992, has touched the lives of thousands of children who have been victims of various forms of abuse and exploitation from the

street, from jail, from prostitution and syndicates and even from their own abusive families and relatives.

Amade-Virlanie Foundation is a unique socio-civic organization in that its approach of community reintegration and mainstreaming have been pioneered since its kids are each provided a home located in a normal community living with real couples acting as surrogate parents, a house-aunt or house-uncle and two social workers. Hence, children are provided the best possible care through the various developmental services simulating the set up of a typical

Filipino family.

At 22, Andrea is the eldest child of Her Royal Highness Princess Caroline of Monaco by her second husband, Stefano Casiraghi, an heir to an Italian oil fortune. Andrea was born in Monte Carlo and was named for a childhood friend of his father's. He has two younger siblings, Charlotte and Pierre, and a younger half-sister, Princess Alexandra of Monaco. With the death of Rainier in 2005, Andrea's uncle Prince Albert became ruler of Monaco; Andrea became second in line to the throne, after Her Royal Highness Princess Caroline of Monaco.
